About the presenter:

Charlene Dunn is an AKC & ASCA Tracking and AKC & UKC Rally judge. With over two decades of experience in Obedience and Tracking, she owner handled the first All American CT with all 5 tracking titles. She has Champion Tracker titles on 3 distinct breeds (Labradors, Dachshunds, and All-Americans). In addition, she has handled multiple dogs to their TD titles. In Obedience her dogs have earned multiple CDs, CDX, along with all levels of Rally in both AKC and UKC up to RAE. All of her dogs are Canine Good Citizens. In other venues she had 1 Lab licensed to work as a therapy dog from TDI, 2 Labs with the highest level Water Rescue titles (WTXX), and 1 Lab cleared for search and rescue.

She believes all dogs should have a basis in obedience for focus & control and tracking gives them an avenue for “work”. As many breeds do, her Labs, Dachshund, and BC/Basset mix liked to have “jobs”. She has taught tracking for 15 years having worked with over 40 breeds and many mixed breeds. She teaches all levels of AKC & ASCA tracking, and beginning level Schutzhund.
