Novice (Birch), Advanced (Anise), Superior (Clove), Masters (Myrrh) & Elite (Vetiver)

**Pre-Trials:** \$15.00 for Pre-entry & \$18.00 for Day of Show

**Elements:** \$20.00 for Pre-entry & \$25.00 for Day of Show

**Special Rate:** All 10 element searches for the same dog is \$175.00 or 8 element searches for the same dog is \$145.00 (Pre-entry only).

**Pre-Entries must be received by February 25, 2019. Please make the checks payable to “ETC” and mail with the 2-page entry form (including ORT documentation if applicable) to the trial secretary listed below.**

**If the trial limit has not been met, *Day of Show* entries will be accepted for Trial 1, provided they are received ½ hour prior to the start of the trials. For Trial 2, *Day of Show* entries will be taken before the conclusion of Trial 1.**

**Important Notice - Parking Pass:** *The fairground has a daily fee of \$5.00 to park with no in & out privileges. You can purchase an in/out pass at a discounted rate of \$12.50 for all 3 days. Please submit your parking pass request separate from your entry. We need to order the passes early from the Fairgrounds. The deadline for submitting payment and a request for a parking pass is February 18, 2019. Passes will be mailed out. Please be sure your correct mailing address is included with your payment. ETC is not responsible for the non-delivery of mail.*

***Vehicle trials depend upon the donation of participant vehicles. We are a small club and cannot personally provide all required vehicles. We rely on your participation! It has not been an issue in the past. However, if we do not receive a sufficient number of vehicles, we will have to cancel the vehicle search. We will begin asking for vehicle donation commitments via email prior to the show and hope you'll help us out!***

***In order to help us continue to secure vehicles, dogs are Strongly Encouraged to wear booties for vehicle searches. Booties will be available to borrow at the trial. Any damage to vehicles will be the sole responsibility of the dog's owner.***

**GENERAL INFORMATION FOR FILLING OUT THE ENTRY FORMS:  
Only the UKC Approved Nosework Entry Forms will be accepted.**

**A and B SECTIONS:** Exhibitors must specify on the entry form if they are going to compete in the A or B section for each search. Both sections will have the same search.

- 'A' Section is for teams that are completely new to the sport (have not earned a NW title).
- 'B' Section is for all other teams listed below:
  - Have earned an equivalent title in another Nosework organization, such as NACSW.
  - Are a licensed or professional dog trainer, Nosework instructor, or a person licensed to officiate in Nosework any organization

**Photography:** No Show Photographer will be available for the trial.

**Crating:** Crating space is available inside.

**Move-Up Policy:** Move-ups will be allowed at this trial. **Move ups MUST be turned in no later than 1/2 hour after the end of that day's trial.**

**Substitution Policy:** No substitution of dogs will be allowed.

**Awards and Prizes:** Placement ribbons will be provided for 1-4 placements in each class. Blue qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. There will also be title ribbons.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

1. **Dogs MUST be UKC registered.** A UKC Registration Number, a Limited Privilege or Temporary Listing number is required with your entry in order to participate. For information on UKC registration go to [www.ukcdogs.com](http://www.ukcdogs.com).
2. A UKC PT or NACSW ORT is required for entry in a UKC element title trial for the level/odor entered. A copy of an ORT needs to be sent with the entry.
3. Handlers are only allowed to run 1 dog per element level or PT level.
4. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc.
5. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds.
6. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
7. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs.
8. Neither ETC, nor the United Kennel Club, Inc. is responsible for theft, loss, accident or injury to any dog, person or property at any of their events. Aggressive behavior by dogs shall not be tolerated at UKC events. **See Waiver on Entry Form.**
9. UKC will vigorously support any motel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
