CLASS INFORMATION, JUMP HEIGHTS , SCORING : Classes offered: Regular Titling; Novice A & B. Open, Excellent/Master for Standard and JWW. Preferred: Novice, Open, Excellent/Master for Standard and JWW . Owners are responsible for entering the proper class and height. All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading from the American Kennel Club Website <http://www.akc.org/rules/>

AGILITY EQUIPMENT FOR THIS TRIAL IS BEING **PROVIDED BY VALENCIA VALLEY KENNEL CLUB** and will comply with the most current Rules and Regulations for Agility Trials

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/ WARM-UPS: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. Walk thrus for the excellent/Master class will be divided by Small (4"-16") and Tall (20"-26") and will be Walk –Run/Walk –Run In the order the trail is being run for the day A warm up jump will be provided.

AWARDS: Strip ribbons will be awarded to the 1st-4th place dog in each jump height in each class. The placement ribbons will conform with the colors set by AKC. Green Qualifying strip ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title. Rosette and Brass Medallion will be presented to handlers finishing a MACH/PACH title during the event. Championship Bars will also be awarded for MACH/PACH Title. All prizes and awards must be claimed the day of the trial. No prize/award will be mailed.

RV PARKING RESERVATIONS: Self-contained RV parking is permitted on the south side of the site at no charge. Electrical and water hookups are available at \$25/night. Contact the Sheriff's Posse Representative upon arrival. All vehicles with generators turned on must be parked at least 50 feet from the arena during show hours. No dumping of holding tanks, grey water or sewage on the trial grounds or parking lot is permitted. The grounds are fenced, but there is no overnight security at the trial site.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE: Traveling NORTH on I-25, take Exit 233 to Alameda Blvd. West on Alameda to Second Street. Turn right (north) on Second St. Proceed approximately 0.8 miles to an unpaved road just past the BERNALILLO COUNTY SHERIFF'S POSSE sign. Turn right (east) onto the unpaved road and follow to the arena.

Travelling southbound on I-25, take Exit 234 (Tramway/Roy Rd) and turn right (west). Go 1.4 miles to the roundabout, and take the 2nd exit onto NM 556W for 0.5 miles, then go turn left (Second St.). Drive approximately 0.6 miles to the unpaved road to the BERNALILLO COUNTY SHERIFF'S POSSE grounds which will be on the left (east).

SITE INFORMATION: These trials will be held in a livestock facility. Livestock may be present in pens adjacent to the rings and crating areas. A blind will be placed between the animals and the rings to minimize visual distractions. Rings will be defined with temporary fencing which may not provide a solid barrier around the ring. As is the case in all trials, the handler must be able to maintain reasonable off-leash control of his/her dog in these settings.

Parking: There is ample parking in the large lot surrounding the arena. Please do not park or set up crates in the fire zone. No parking spaces will be reserved overnight. Please do not park in marked/coned areas designated for workers/judge/club members.

Crating: There is ample crating on the north side of the arena and under the bleachers on the south side. Please do not set crates up in the fire zone or in the bleachers. You may bring EZ-Ups and other tents for shade, but please be aware that wind is often an issue in Albuquerque. Crates may be left overnight, however, Valencia Valley Kennel Club and the BCSP will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and parking areas.

DO NOT TAKE YOU OR YOUR DOGS TO THE GRASS AREA IN FRONT OF THE BUILDING TO THE WEST OF THE ARENA. This is a private residence and **ANYONE** found over there will be immediately excused from the trial with no refund.

Do not take dogs into the restrooms.

Do not leave dogs overnight at the show site.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. You should always have a copy of your rabies vac. Certificate with you when you travel with your dog

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR , LIABILITY: Members of the Valencia Valley Kennel Club, and their agents, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs, or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children and guests.

VVKC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against VVKC or any official thereof.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all of the obstacles safely. **All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm up area.** It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) guest(s) and /or children. Those engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the site. In such cases there will be no refund of fees paid.

In consideration of others you will be expected to clean up after yourself and your dogs at the event site and at your motel. Failure to do so may be cause for dismissal.

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have Limited Registration, Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) PAL Number, Mixed Breeds that have a Canine Partner Listing number (CPL) or Approved FSS Breeds, with the exception of bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dogs' physical or mental performance. For a complete description of other physical disqualifications please refer to Chapter 1, Sec 3. For the listing of registerable breeds that may participate refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fees will be refunded for dogs withdrawn after the closing date **except** for bitches who come into season or any dogs who are withdrawn due to a change of judge(s), providing the Event Secretary receives notice in writing at the beginning of the day of the trial . No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, violent acts of nature, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee. All regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the event committee will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list

Faxed, telephoned, scanned and emailed, or unsigned or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance. **A maximum of 10 Entries per envelope is allowed.** Envelopes with more than the 10 dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee and are subject to an added collection fee. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed, except as provided for in chapter 11, section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

ENTRY RECEIVED NOTICES; All those who send a legible email address will receive notice that entry has been received- **Please check for errors and report them immediately!!** If you do not have an email address you may send a self addressed stamped envelope for entry received verification

Vendors: VVKC is accepting applications for vendors for this event and a list of those vendors will be published in the final confirmation to exhibitors.

Food Vendor: Concession stand "Our Daily Bread" will be available during all three days of the event. This is the vendor that everyone loved at our April Show.

Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date: One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check NO my dog does not need to be measured, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date: A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. **Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement:** If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Request Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox.

Third measurement tie breakers and challenge measurement rules can be found in Regulations for Agility Trials Chapter 2, Section 4. Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession. **It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.***

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner _____
