Day to day move-ups welcomed.

We will run the trial by level in order to limit the number of individuals on site. This means all four elements for a given level (for example, Masters) will be run before the next scheduled level (Excellent) begins.

Parking is limited. In order to allow us to accommodate as many cars as possible, we ask that everyone park close to one another. Unfortunately, **RV's cannot be accommodated on site.**

NO indoor crating is available at this trial. Please be prepared to crate out of your vehicle.

We will be practicing COVID 19 safety procedures as per state and local guidelines at the time of the trial. Final schedule and run order will be determined by the Covid 19 guidelines current at the time of the trial as well as the number of entries in each class. This schedule cannot be set until we have the latest public health order and all entries have been processed.

ELIGIBLE DOGS

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter.

Females in season may not participate. Aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

ENTRY FEES

An entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class.

First entry each element \$20 (includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

Additional entries in the same trial..... \$20 (includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

No entries by phone or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Vikki Welby at vkw3342@gmail.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

Sandia Dog Obedience Club will be offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries. A limit of 15 entries will be held on the waitlist.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s) and will include a waiting area.

Handler's Briefing will take place after the Demo Dog has run. The briefing, at the Judge's discretion, will be either a group briefing prior to the start of each class OR an individual briefing on the line prior to your run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search.

A **warm-up area** will be available consisting of ONE marked container of each odor being tested at the trial and may also consist of blanks containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their run, or for recovery after the run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog. Please be considerate of others using the area.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

Search Area Conditions. Searches may be indoors, on matted, concrete, carpeted, dirt, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

Search Area Sizes will be as stated in the AKC regulations for all elements and levels.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training. No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. Please be considerate and leave the area as clean as you found it.

Spectators are encouraged where the venue configuration reasonably allows it. The judge's determination of appropriate location for spectators is final. It may be possible for a single individual to accompany a team to video. Any individual serving as the designated videographer for a running dog does so at the sole responsibility of the running team. Interference in the run by a videographer is at the risk of the running team.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

A New Title ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to read and understand the current regulations for Scent Work prior to participating in this event. All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Scent Work, by downloading them here:

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

COLLARS, LEASHES AND HARNESSSES

During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search.

REFUNDS

Should the event be cancelled due to covid, entry fees will be refunded. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

FINAL CONFIRMATION EMAIL

A final confirmation email will be sent out one week prior to trial. This email will include a full schedule of run orders, current COVID 19 guidelines, check-in location and times of check-in.
