TRACKING TEST RULES

1. ENTRIES:

- A. Entries for the Tracking Dog Test shall be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached, and a drawing will be held within 48 hours of the closing date to determine which entries will participate in the test. Preference shall be given to dogs that have not previously earned the Tracking Dog title. In addition, preference for up to the first 2 tracks drawn will be given to SDOC test workers who submit an SDOC issued worker certification with their entry form.
- B. If a drawing is necessary, it will take place at Sandia Dog Obedience Club, 7050 San Pedro Dr NE, Albuquerque, NM 87109, on February 17 at 7:00PM. **Entrants will be notified by phone or email as soon as possible on that day.** Alternates shall be given the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternates list. Those who accept shall be placed on the list in the order they were drawn. Those who decline shall have their entry fee and certification returned.
- C. Entries shall be listed in the catalog according to the drawing, including the list of alternate entries drawn after the limit of Six (6) is reached. In the event that an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, alternates will be allowed to participate in the order listed in the catalog. Entry fees will be refunded within seven days following the test to alternates who do not participate.
- D. The Trial Committee reserves the right to cancel the trial in the event of extreme weather conditions as per AKC directive dated July 23, 1995.

2. BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE. The Test Secretary and judges must be notified that a bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for bitch(es) in season. Bitches in season shall be allowed on the tracking field only immediately prior to their running.

3. PARKING: All cars must park only in designated areas. These are private properties, so please drive slowly and respect the land and personal property.

4. ENTRY FORM: Use the AKC entry form and write "TD" in the obedience space. Include Certification. Mail entry application, certification, and fees to the Test Secretary.

5. ENTRY FEE: The Entry Fee listed (\$75) includes the AKC Recording Fee and the AKC Event Service Fee.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRACKING TEST SITE

Take I-40 East to the second Moriarty exit, Highway 41. Go south 17 miles to Estancia. Continue 6 miles south to Highway 542, turn right and continue for 4 miles to Akin Farm Road. Turn right and proceed 2 miles to 150 Akin Farm Road on the right.

The drawing for the running order of tracks will be held near the barn at 8:45 AM.

* From Test Site: Take I-40 west to Eubank Avenue. Go north to Montgomery Ave and turn right. Clinic is on the north side of Montgomery about .25 miles.

Open 24 hours every day of the week. This is about 64 miles from the test site.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.)
