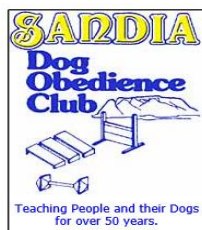

### ENTER YOUR TEAM!

This trial offers the super fun opportunity on Friday, September 29<sup>th</sup> for teams of four dogs and handlers to compete in Team Obedience.

Team consists of the novice obedience exercises of heel on leash with figure 8, stand for exam, and heel free, plus the drop on recall. For the drop on recall, the dogs are called and downed one by one. There are also group sits and downs. (Cont. on next page)

There is one entry fee for each team, but all four dogs must be entered in the class. Please submit all four entries together in one envelope.

If you want music for your team, there is a PA system at the Horse Arena. You can plug in your cell phone or tablet to the mixer, or you can tell me your selection and I can download it from iTunes to my iPhone (just make sure it is on iTunes). If you want to use your own device to plug into the mixer, check with me to make sure it's compatible.

So, how about it? Form your team, pick your theme, assemble your costumes, select your music, and then practice separately and together before the trials.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES

1. Fees must accompany entries. Sandia Dog Obedience Club assumes no responsibility for incomplete or inaccurate information on the entry form or for a dog being entered in a class for which it is not eligible.
2. Entries must be on the most current official American Kennel Club entry form. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone, facsimile or emailed entries will not be accepted. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours following the opening date and time.
3. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. A withdrawal from the trial after the closing date due to an injury or illness to the dog will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. A veterinarian's note will be required for the refund to be issued. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in obedience or rally trials. As such, the club will refund 100% per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason. In order to receive either refund, the trial secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class on the first day of the trials.
4. All mail must be addressed to the Trial Secretary's address. Priority and Express mail must be sent with a waiver of signature requirements.
5. Acknowledgement of entry received will be sent to the email address listed on the entry form, provided that said address is legible. All final confirmations and Judging Programs will also be sent via email.
6. Sandia Dog Obedience Club is not responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, whether it results from an accident or other cause. It is to be clearly understood that every dog at this trial is in the care, custody and control of the owner or his/her agent at all times.
7. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging
8. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring at the appropriate time. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward or any other officer or agent of the club to locate any dog for judging
9. Class placement ribbons and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. Prizes awarded for competition between classes will be awarded after completion of judging all classes at the trial. All prizes must be picked up the day of the trial; none will be mailed..
10. In the event of a tie score for any award, it will be the responsibility of the handler to have the dog available for a runoff. Any dog not present for the runoff forfeits its right to the award.
11. No double handling will be permitted at this trial. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Trial Committee
12. The Trial Committee reserves the right to cancel the trial in the event of extreme weather conditions as per AKC directive dated July 23, 1995.
13. Members and officers of the SDOC and the Trial Committee, as well as their family members, will be allowed to show dogs at these trials.

## PARKING

All parking is paid parking. Daily passes (no in and out privileges) are \$10 each day and must be purchased at Gate 3 (San Pedro and Copper). Exhibitors may obtain prepaid parking passes through SDOC. These passes are good for all three days and allow unlimited entry and exit to Expo NM. **To obtain a parking pass, send a check for \$15 payable to SDOC and a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope to Donna Crary-Johnson, 4829 Shin Ave NE, Rio Rancho, NM 87144. All requests must be received by September 13<sup>th</sup> so we can get the passes to you before the trial.** No overnight parking except for RVs.

## RV PARKING

RV Parking is \$40/night for full hook-ups, and \$30/night for dry camping. To reserve a spot, email Donna Crary-Johnson at [draussie@g.com](mailto:draussie@g.com) with your name, email address, date and time of arrival, a description of your RV, and whether you are requesting full hook up or dry camping. When you arrive, enter through Gate 3 (San Pedro and Copper), go to the stop sign and pull into one of the parking lots. Call the 24/7 security guard at (505) 401-4095, and they will take you to your site and collect your money. Expo will mail you an invoice.

## DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

*Please note that the Sandia Mountains are to the East of Albuquerque*

**From I-40 East:** Exit onto Louisiana Blvd. (Exit 162) and head south. Turn right (west) onto Lomas Blvd, then left onto San Pedro. From San Pedro, you may enter through Gate 6, the first gate on the left, with a prepaid parking pass; otherwise, enter through Gate 3 at Copper. The Horse Arena is in the northeast end of the Fairgrounds, next to the Dairy Barn.

**From I-40 West:** Exit San Mateo south (Exit 161A). Turn left (east) onto Lomas and right (south) onto San Pedro. Then follow the above directions for Gate 6 and Gate 3.



## MEAL OPTIONS

A food truck, the very popular One Stop Chill and Fill, will be at the trials on Friday and Saturday for breakfast and lunch, starting at about 9:30 am.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
