## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES

1. Fees must accompany entries. Sandia Dog Obedience Club assumes no responsibility for incomplete or inaccurate information on the entry form or for a dog being entered in a class for which it is not eligible.
2. Entries must be on a current, official American Kennel Club entry form. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone, facsimile or emailed entries will not be accepted.
3. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee
4. Entry fees will be refunded for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial. A veterinarian's note is not required. In addition, SDOC will refund 75% of entry fees to dogs that are unable to compete due to injury. In order to receive a refund, the trial secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, and a note from the dog's veterinarian must be provided for injured dogs.
5. All mail must be addressed to the Trial Secretary's address. Priority and Express mail must be sent with a **waiver of signature requirements**.
6. The Trial Committee may decline any entry for cause or may remove any dog on account of sickness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against Sandia Dog Obedience Club or any official thereof, nor the Trial Secretary
7. Sandia Dog Obedience Club is not responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, whether it results from an accident or other cause. It is to be clearly understood that every dog at this trial is in the care, custody and control of the owner or his/her agent at all times.
8. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging
9. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring at the appropriate time. It is not the responsibility of the ring steward or any other officer or agent of the club to locate any dog for judging
10. Class placement ribbons and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. Prizes awarded for competition between classes will be awarded after completion of judging all classes at the trial. All prizes must be picked up the day of the trial; none will be mailed.
11. In the event of a tie score for any award, it will be the responsibility of the handler to have the dog available for a runoff. Any dog not present for the runoff forfeits its right to the award.
12. No double handling will be permitted. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Trial Committee.
13. A Recording fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for each recordable single entry class are included in the entry fees in the Obedience trial. Rally entry fees include an AKC recording fee of \$3.50 for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in Rally. These fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.
14. The Trial Committee reserves the right to cancel the trial in the event of extreme weather conditions as per AKC directive dated July 23, 1995.
15. Members and officers of the SDOC, trial committee members, the trial secretary, and family members of those listed will be allowed to show dogs at these trials.
16. All exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs at this trial site. Those failing to do so will be subject to official action
17. **NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN BUILDING OVERNIGHT. ALL DOORS WILL BE LOCKED FROM 10PM TO 6AM EACH DAY**

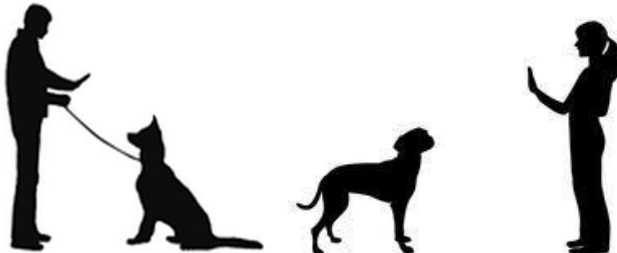

Infectious disease precautions taken at the High Desert Cluster are subject to change. Following are current preparations being taken by the High Desert Cluster Clubs and Expo New Mexico:

### RING PREPARATIONS

- Separate entry and exit at each ring.
- Hand sanitizer available at each ring and throughout the show site.
- Masks available for those that prefer or are required to wear one at rings.
- Each judge will have their own mask policy in a ring. Masks will either be required or optional. The policy for each ring will be posted at multiple locations for that ring. Please respect and comply with the policy. Appropriate action will be taken for refusal to comply with a judge's mask wearing policy.
- Ringside seating will NOT be provided. Individuals can sit ringside but must provide their own seating.

### SHOW SITE PREPARATIONS & INFORMATION

- Hand sanitizer available throughout the show site.
- Masks available for those that prefer to wear one at the show site.
- When in public spaces, the State of New Mexico may have a mask mandate. While sporadic, there have been incidences of enforcement of the mask mandate throughout the pandemic.
- Masked or unmasked, everyone is welcome at the High Desert Cluster. Please respect each individual's choice.

### SIGNED WAIVER

The High Desert Cluster Clubs and Expo New Mexico do not plan to require attendees to sign a waiver. The hold harmless waiver on the AKC entry form addresses COVID-19 and many other situations.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

If this entry is for Junior Showmanship, please give the following information:
