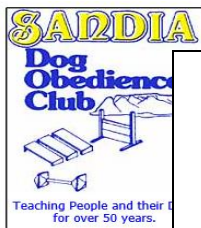

AVMA Statement: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. When traveling with your dogs, you should always have copies of their rabies vaccination certificates.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. Ring size will be 100ft x 100ft. The rings will be defined with temporary fencing, with gates that open and close.

First entry of each dog, each day (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee)..... \$20

No online entries will be accepted. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No hand-delivered entries within the first 24 hours after opening. Inquiries may be directed to Lisa Frankland at lisakblue@comcast.net. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

JUNIOR HANDLER DISCOUNTS: SDOC offers ½ price entry fees for handlers under the age of 18. An AKC Junior Handler number must be included on the Entry Form. To obtain a free Junior Handler number, call the AKC at (919) 233-9767.

Handler substitutions can be made before entries close by paying additional entry fees. No handler substitutions allowed after the closing date/time. Refunds will not be given if the assigned Junior is unavailable to handle the dog.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

No refunds will be issued for amounts less than \$15

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund 100% per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason. In order to receive a refund, the handler must notify the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. **Dogs that are injured** after closing will be refunded up to 75% of their entry fees provided that the Trial Secretary is notified prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials and a signed note from a veterinarian is provided.

CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING TIMES

There will be a general briefing no earlier than 7:30 each morning, with judging of the first class to commence at 8:00 am. Class order is tentative and subject to change based on entry numbers. A final class schedule will be sent to all exhibitors after closing.

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MIXED HEIGHTS & CLASSES

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

FEO & FIX and GO ON

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Fix and Go On

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place.....	White
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A special "QQ" medallion will be given to anyone who earns a Double Q in Master Standard and Master Jumpers on the same day. A special rosette and decorated bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH/PAX. All awards must be claimed by the end of the trial. None will be mailed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Sandia Dog Obedience Club, Expo New Mexico and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. **Sandia Dog Obedience Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression.** No one shall have any recourse or claim against Sandia Dog Obedience Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. **The entire Expo New Mexico property is considered the trial grounds.**

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions or the Trial Committee will be strictly enforced; including, but not limited to, the recorded information in this premium list.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

The Horse Arena is located on the campus of Expo New Mexico. It is climate controlled with a packed dirt surface. There is plenty of room for crating and lots of space for walking dogs outdoors.

Parking: All parking is paid parking. Daily passes (no in and out privileges) are \$10.00 each day and must be purchased at Gate 3 (San Pedro and Copper). Exhibitors may obtain prepaid parking passes through SDOC. These passes are good for all three days and allow unlimited entry and exit to Expo NM. **To obtain a parking pass, send a check for \$15 payable to SDOC and a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope to Peggy Chandler, 1472 Coronado Rd, Corrales, NM 87048. All requests must be received no later than April 17th so we can get the passes to you before the trial.** No overnight parking except for RVs.

RV Parking is \$40/night for full hook-ups, and \$30/night for dry camping. **To reserve a spot, email Peggy Chandler by April 17th at chuckchandler1@comcast.net** with your name, email address, date and time of arrival, and a description of your RV and what services you are requesting (full hook up or dry). When you arrive, enter through Gate 3 (Copper and San Pedro), go to the stop sign and pull into one of the parking lots. Call the 24/7 security guard at (505) 401-4095, and they will take you to your site and take your money. Expo will mail you an invoice.

Crating is on floors in the building lobby and side entries of the arena. No crating allowed in the bleachers. Crates may be left overnight; however, Sandia Dog Obedience Club and Expo NM are not responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the trial site. Security is provided by Expo NM. Doors are locked at 6:00 pm and opened at 6:30 am. No dogs may be left in the building overnight.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and parking areas.

Seating space is ample at this location - there are bleachers on both the east and west sides of the arena. Due to safety and space concerns, no exhibitor or spectator chairs will be allowed between the rings.

A food vendor may not be available for this site. There are a few restaurants and convenience stores within a short distance of the trial grounds, or you may bring your own food and drink.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to comply may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. There will be cleaning supplies and trash cans at various locations throughout the trial grounds.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes in which they are entered are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

CATALOGS

A limited number of catalogs will be available for viewing at the trial secretary booth. None will be sold. Running order sheets will be emailed to all exhibitors at no charge after closing.

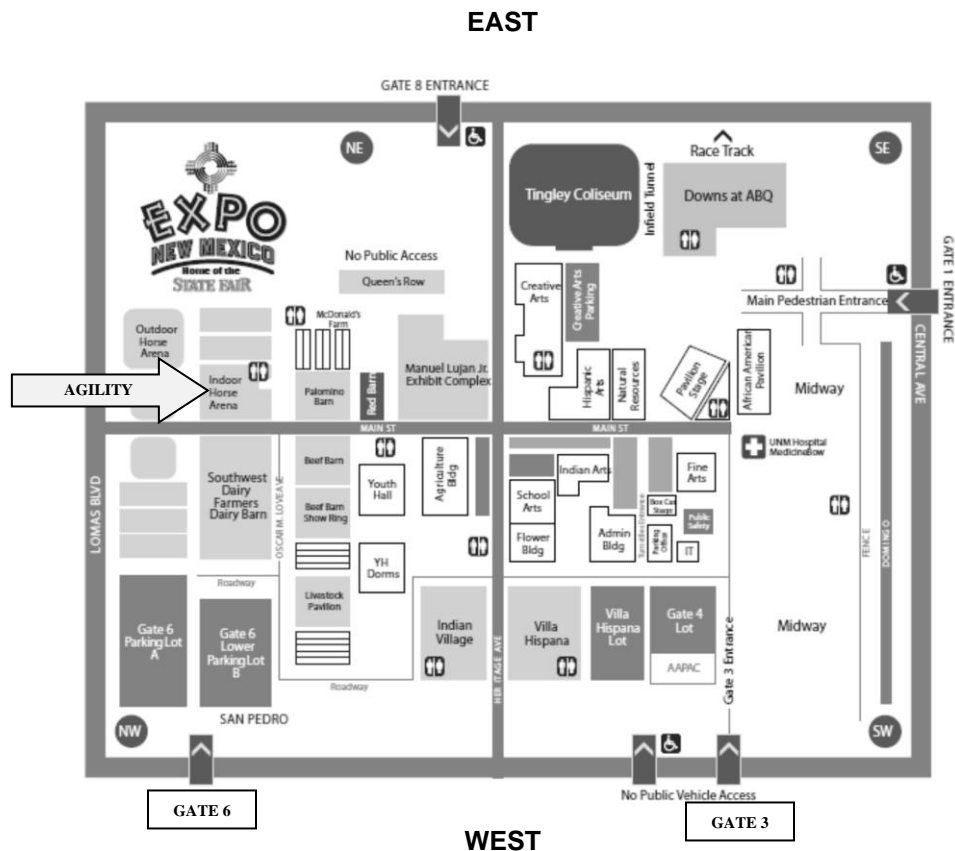

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From I-40 East: Exit onto Louisiana Blvd. (Exit 162) and head south. Turn right (west) onto Lomas Blvd, then left onto San Pedro. From San Pedro, you may enter through Gate 6, the first gate on the left, with a prepaid parking pass; otherwise, enter through Gate 3 at Copper. The Horse Arena is in the northeast corner of the of the Fairgrounds, next to the Dairy Barn.

From I-40 West: Exit San Mateo south (Exit 161A). Turn left (east) onto Lomas and right (south) onto San Pedro. Then follow the above directions for Gate 6 and Gate 3 .

(Note: The Sandia Mountains are east of Albuquerque)
