### **ACT (Agility Course Test)**

**Saturday—ACT 1, 2 rounds to follow regular Agility Trial Classes (approx. time 1pm)**

**Sunday—ACT 2, 2 rounds to follow regular Agility Trial Classes (approx. time 1pm)**

The Agility Course Test (ACT) is an entry level agility event designed to introduce and welcome beginning dogs and their handlers to the AKC Sport of Dog Agility.

There are two levels of ACT: ACT1 and ACT2. ACT 1 is designed for the beginning level dog to show beginning sequencing and performance skills. ACT 2 requires an increased skill level shown by the additional obstacles to be performed.

In addition to showing your dog's entry level skills & gaining ring experience, new exhibitors will learn some important basic information about entering & competing in AKC Agility. Designed to help make your first real Agility trial not so scary...for both you & your dog!

### **Earn an ACT 1 and/or ACT 2 title in one weekend!!!**

ACT titles require just 2 passing scores & both can be earned under the same judge evaluator on the same day. So it's possible to earn both an ACT 1 and ACT 2 title at our event!!

### **WHO CAN ENTER?**

Dogs must be at least 15 months of age and meet the physical requirements for a regular AKC Agility Trial.

**The dog cannot have earned any AKC agility title.**

Dog do NOT need to be AKC registered to enter ACT.

\*\*Dogs without registration numbers will be issued a temporary one after the event by the AKC office. If a dog handler team has qualified at an event with an unregistered dog, they will be sent a query to register the dog after the event.

**Dogs do NOT need to have an ACT 1 Title to enter ACT 2 Enter just ACT 1. Enter just ACT 2. Or feel free to enter BOTH!!!**

### **PERFORMANCE AND TITLES:**

#### **ACT 1:**

- Run a course at any height (10-12 obstacles)
- A Frame (5'), Table, Jumps (No Spreads) Open Tunnels.
- Complete the entire course in 60 seconds or less with a score of 85, no dropped bars, no missed contacts, no more than 3 attempts to complete any obstacle, no more than 3 wrong courses.
- 2 qualifying legs to title
- Act 1 Title and Certificate\*\*\*

#### **ACT 2: You do not have to have an ACT 1 title to enter ACT 2 Classes**

- Run a course at any height (11-13 Obstacles)
- A Frame (5'), Teeter, Dog Walk (allowed), Table, Jumps, Spread Jump (1), Open Tunnels, 6Weaves.
- Complete the entire course in 70 seconds or less with a score of 85, no dropped bars, no missed contacts, no more than 3 attempts to complete any obstacle, no more than 3 wrong courses.
- 2 qualifying legs to title
- ACT 2 Title and Certificate\*\*\*

\*\*\*Dogs must be AKC registered to receive a physical title certificate from AKC and have the title printed after the dog's name\*\*\*

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at ACT Events

In order to acquire the ACT 1 or ACT 2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered with the American Kennel Club. **AKC Canine Partners®** applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event results.

Dogs that are not AKC Registered may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT Title at that time.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners®** program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the other side of this form. Should you not have your Jr Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919-233-9767) If the Jr Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
